Dear Parents,

The Lycée international français de Vilnius has been closed since March 12 due to the Covid-19 epidemic.

During this first week of closure, the entire educational team has been mobilized to offer online courses and gradually set up distance education. The investment was strong and the result is largely satisfactory.

But, as we never worked like this before, we experiment with various processes, tools, and practices. And, as for all experiments, we can make some mistakes, the same we will rectify as we analyze and learn from them. We work as a team and are supported by experts from the AEFÉ network and by an e-learning consultant.

Discussions are underway to better coordinate daily schedules, strengthen communication and exchanges between parents-teachers-students and maintain a daily link with children. You will soon receive a more detailed letter explaining all this by class level.

In these complicated times, **we need your support and your trust**. The success of the distance learning class depends on our partnership and collaboration. We will soon set up a platform for exchanges between parents (help between parents) and between families and teachers.

We hope to improve our system week after week in order to allow your children, our students, to pass through this difficult situation as smoothly as possible. **Education is at the heart of our priorities and it will continue despite these circumstances.**

Likewise, in these difficult times, the LIFV Management and the Management Board are aware of the difficulty that certain families may have to face. As you know, the Lycée International Français de Vilnius is a private non-profit educational establishment. As such, no profit is made for the service given. However, depending on the Lithuanian Government grants and potentially lighter operating costs during the school closure, a discount may be awarded. However, this will not be known until the end of the school year. We will do our best to inform you as soon as possible.

Rest assured, dear parents, that we are doing everything to ensure the educational continuity of our service and maintain its quality.
