

FAMILY RECEPTION PROTOCOL - SILO Building
(based on the recommendations of the city of Vilnius)

1- People accompanying children to the School (referred to below as **accompanying people**) **are not allowed to enter the building** unless they have an authorization, and only after having been controlled at the checkpoint at the entrance.

They must drop off and pick up their child outside the LIFV, in front of the entrance which will be communicated to them.

2- Communication between accompanying people and LIFV staff will be from outside the buildings and respecting the physical distance of at least 1 m.

3- Accompanying people must present themselves outside the LIFV wearing a protective mask, covering the nose and mouth.

Children older than 6 years old must also be wearing a protective mask to be allowed to enter the school.

4- Accompanying people will only be allowed to leave their child at LIFV after the health personnel have checked the child's state of health. They wait at the checkpoint, then, once their child has been authorized to enter the building, they leave the premises, following the direction of traffic.

5- **If the health personnel notes that the child is in a feverish state** (37.3 ° and more in temperature) or that he/she shows signs of acute upper respiratory tract infections, acute intestinal infections and other communicable diseases (for example, runny nose, cough, difficulty breathing, diarrhea, vomiting, rash), **he/she will not be allowed to enter the building.** In this case, the accompanying person is notified and takes charge of the child immediately.

6- If these symptoms are detected in a child, during the school day, the LIFV administration informs the legal representative who must come to the checkpoint to pick up their child. In the meantime, the child is immediately isolated from the group.

It is recommended for the family to contact the Coronavirus hotline (phone number 1808) or the child's general practitioner for a remote consultation.

The school nurse or her assistant is responsible for monitoring the case. Within 24 hours, she or he should contact the parents to find out if the child or their family is infected with Covid-19.

If this is the case, the LIFV administration will inform the National Center for Public Health of the Ministry of Health (hereinafter - NVSC) and will cooperate with the NVSC to identify the exposed people and place them in solitary confinement for 14 days.

7- Families who know that they or their child have symptoms of Covid-19 or are infected with Covid-19 must imperatively inform the LIFV administration.

The LIFV administration will inform the National Public Health Center of the Ministry of Health (hereafter - NVSC) and will cooperate with the NVSC to identify the exposed people and place them in solitary confinement for 14 days.

8- An after-school daycare service will be available in the morning before class from 10:00 am and after class until 4:30 pm, upon registration only.

9- The accompanying people make sure that the children do not bring toys, cuddly toys and comfort items from home.

10- Any child whose behavior would make it difficult to maintain the operating rules put in place to ensure the health security of staff and his classmates will be isolated from the group and the parents will be called to come and pick him/her up.
