These activities play a vital role in the holistic development of young learners and help foster their creativity and imagination.

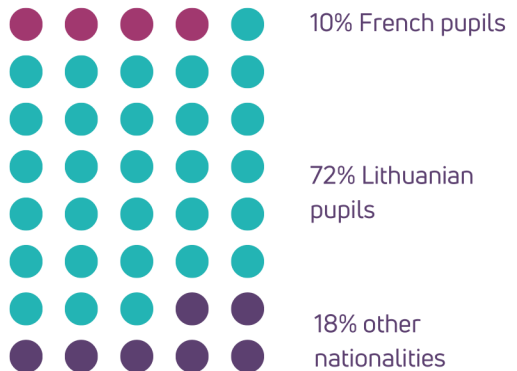

What do we learn in Elementary school?

The French national curriculum is structured around clearly defined programs that outline the essential knowledge and skills students should acquire. These programs include annual benchmarks that help guide the progression of learning in each subject area.

- Mastery of language and the French language is emphasized, covering oral expression, reading, writing, literature, and the study of French language aspects such as grammar, spelling, vocabulary, and conjugation
- Humanitarian education covers community life, history, geography, and introductory lessons in a foreign language such as English
- Scientific education is centered around mathematics, experimental sciences, technology, and computing
- Physical and sports education is designed to promote students' physical health and well-being
- Artistic education focuses on musical education and visual arts, allowing students to express their creativity and develop their artistic abilities
- Finally, civic education or living together is emphasized, aiming to foster a sense of citizenship and prepare students to engage meaningfully in society.



What do we learn in Elementary school?

The teachers responsible for delivering education in this system are trained in French curricula and teaching methods, ensuring that the instruction is aligned with the standards set by the French education system.

In addition to regular classroom instruction, teachers provide complementary educational activities to help students who are experiencing difficulties. These activities take place from 3:20 pm to 4:00 pm.

To ensure that students are making progress, teachers regularly evaluate their achievements and levels. This information is communicated to families through a school booklet and other means, encouraging useful dialogue for the follow-up of the children's schooling.

At the beginning of each school year, information meetings are organized for each level, with additional meetings scheduled throughout the year using different formats.

Furthermore, pupils have the opportunity to participate in numerous educational projects, such as mathematical and scientific challenges, French language competitions and projects, visits by authors of children's literature, educational outings, and themed trips. These activities are organized by teachers in each level and aim to enhance the learning experience of students.

Language programs

LIFV offers a diverse range of language programs in French, Lithuanian, and English. To deliver these programs effectively, the school benefits from the expertise of native French, English, and Lithuanian teachers who provide guidance and support to students.

* In cycle 2 (CP + CE1 + CE2): a 30-minute sequence is taught jointly by the Lithuanian and French teachers to give more meaning to the learning process.

** In cycle 3 (CM1+CM2 + 6e): two 30-minute sequences are taught jointly by the English and French teachers in geography and science.
